List the title of the article in italics. Type the full title of the article in sentence case, capitalizing only the first word and any proper nouns in the title. If there's a subtitle, type a colon after the title followed by the subtitle, also in sentence case. Type a period at the end.

For an APA citation for a journal article with 2 to 20 authors, use a comma between all of the author names. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name. For an article with 21 or more authors, list the names of the first 19 authors and use a comma between all of the names.

If you are paraphrasing an idea from another work, you only have to make reference to the author and year of publication in your in-text reference, but APA guidelines encourage you to also provide the page number (although it is not required). According to Jones (1998), APA style is a difficult citation format for first-time learners.

Basic Form. APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

The APA citation style is a parenthetical author-date style, meaning that you need to put the author's last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that have no page numbers, use a paragraph number, for example: (Field, 2005, para. 1).
